# PROPHECIES FULFILLED BY JESUS IN THE CRUCIFIXION

**Psalm 41:9**

"Even my close friend...has lifted up his heel against me"

**Mark 14:10** "Then Judas Iscariot, one of the Twelve, went to the chief priests to betray Jesus"

**Isaiah 53:3** "He was despised... and we esteemed him not"

**John 1:10-11** "...though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him"

**Zechariah 11:12**

"I told them, 'If you think it best, give me my pay; but if not, keep it.' So they paid me 30 pieces of silver"

**Matt 26:14-16**

"...Judas...asked.. 'What are you willing to give me if I hand him over to you?' So they counted for him 30 silver coins"

**Isaiah 53:7**

"He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth"

**Mark 15:3** "But Jesus still made no reply, and Pilate was amazed"

King David lived 1,000 years before Jesus.

**"About the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice..."**

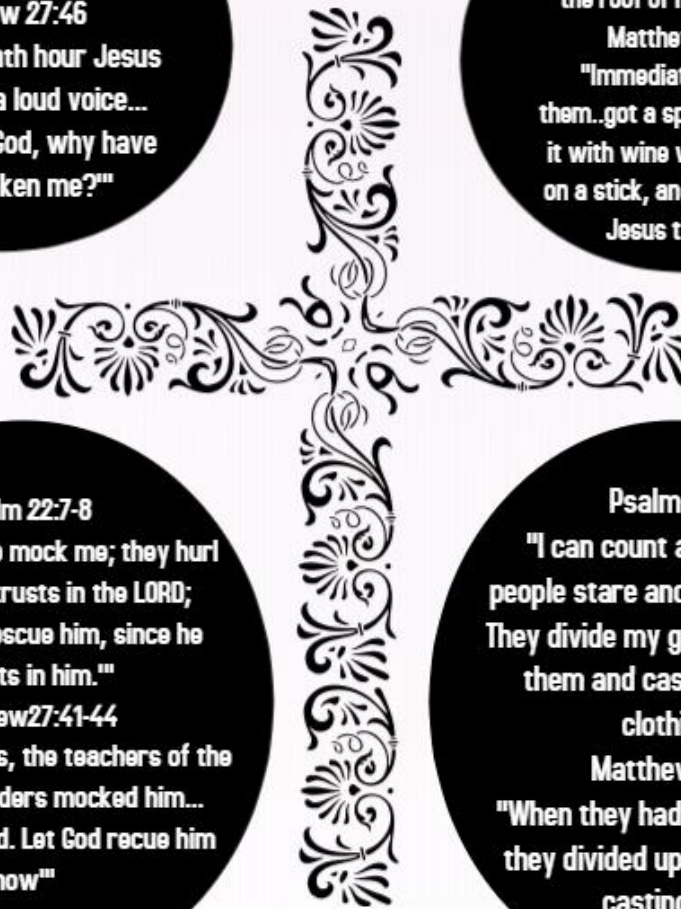
**'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?'"**

**Psalm 22:7-8**

**"All who see me mock me; they hurl insults... "He trusts in the LORD; let the LORD rescue him, since he delights in him.""**

**Matthew 27:41-44**

**"The chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him..."**

**'He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now'"**

**Psalm 22:15**

**"I can count all my bones; people stare and gloat over me. They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing."**

**Matthew 27:35**

**"When they had crucified him, they divided up his clothes by casting lots"**
